

Usage of third party codecs

If Divx is not installed, recorded Video will not play in your Windows Media Player. It should be installed by default on the Server itself. We have seen some instances where installing just Monitor Station does not correctly setup with the Divx5 Codec and we have had to follow up the Monitor Station install with the Divx codec.

Whereas Divx is used for your recorded video, Morgan Codec is used for certain aspects of streaming video. Again, this should be part of the main installation of a Monitor Station setup but we have found that on rare occasions that it doesn't install properly and have had to manually follow up the install of the Monitor Station with the Morgan Codec.

FFDShow is not really necessary unless you are in a hybrid environment using a VNH240 card (this is our 8 channel card that provides you with a 720 x 480 resolution).

If you have Morgan and FFDShow installed, it shouldn't matter if MJPEG is checked, the important part is the De-Interlacing option which should be turned on.
