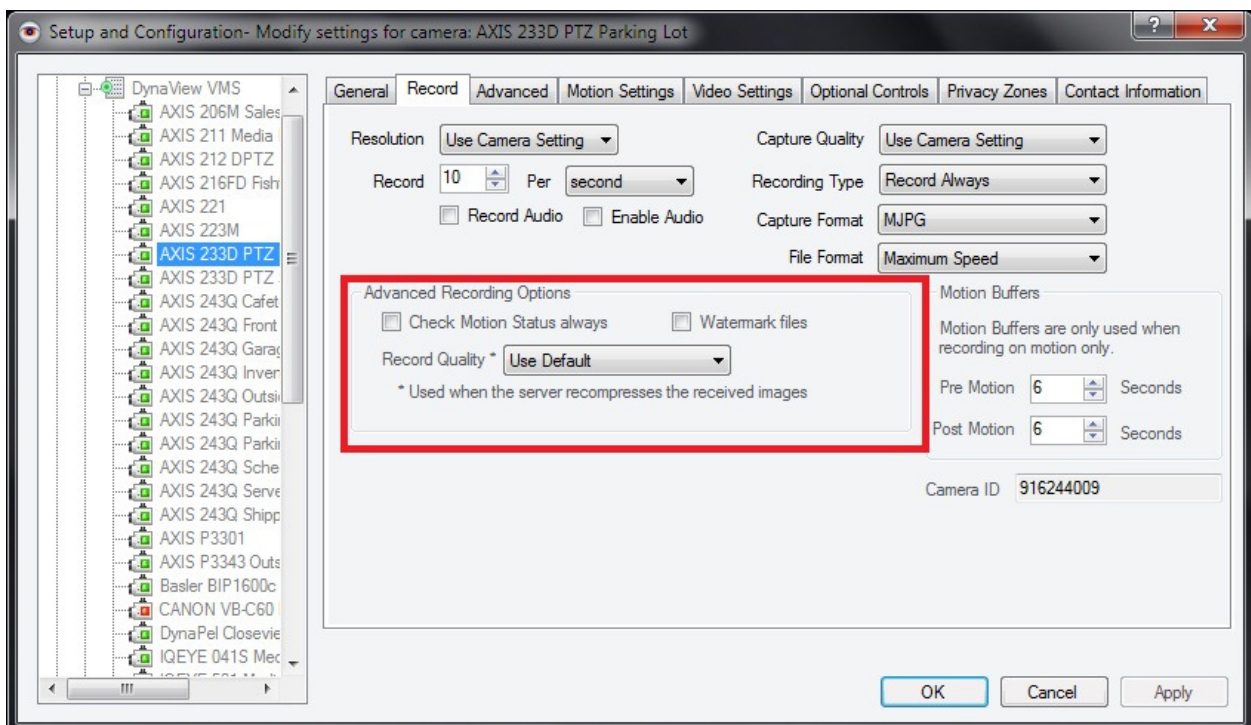


Watermarking

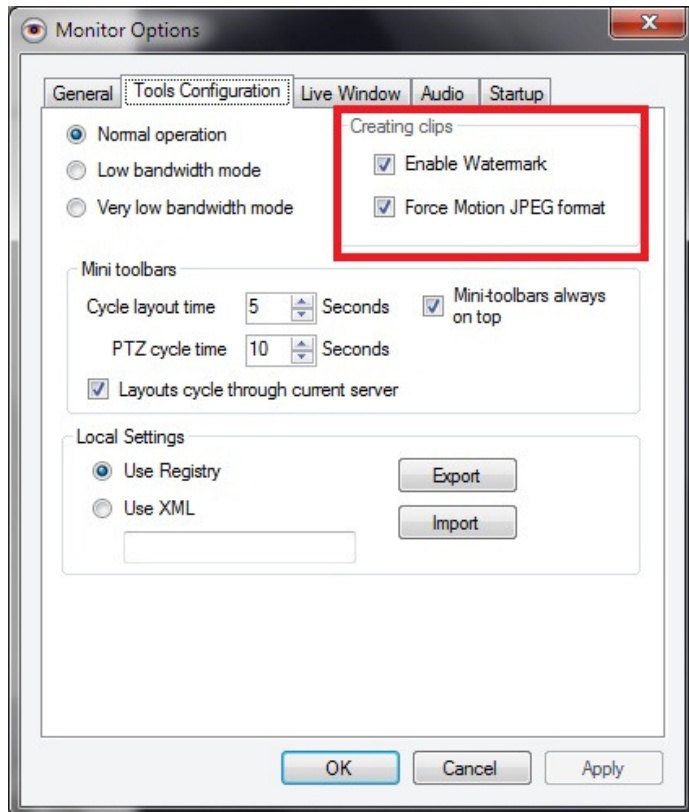
Watermarking can be applied to video in two ways. First, all video that is recorded by IP Server can be watermarked. The watermark that is applied is a digital watermark not a visual one. This is essentially a numerical checksum appended to the end of the video recording. This has minimal impact on the server resource utilization, except when the file save action occurs. This will cause a delay when the IP Server is stopped.

This watermark can be enabled by selecting the Advanced Settings on the Record Tab of the Setup and Configuration tool. Check the Watermark Files checkbox to enable continual watermarking.



The second application of watermark occurs at time of export.

A watermark can be applied to each clip that is exported from Monitor Station. Select the Tools -> Options and Tools Configuration tab. Check the Enable Watermark checkbox to enable watermarking on exported clips. This has no resource impact on the server, as all of the rendering takes place in Monitor Station on the client.



In either case, the standalone player can verify the watermark.
