AVfusion Release Notes

Overview

IPVideo Corporation is pleased to announce the latest version of AVfusion which will be made available to all new users as well as those customers who have current Software Upgrade Protection (SUP) for their systems.

The new version, AVfusion 2020 R2.1, includes a rich new set of features as well as addresses some ease-of-use issues requested by our customers. Included in this version is the ability to automatically export video to a backup location and to keep track of whether the video has been placed in an evidence locker (Vault). Also included is the ability to perform a quick record by simply hitting the AVfusion Remote Start button.

In the ease-of-use category, there are enhancements to Active Directory and the software installation process which greatly reduces the load on IT personnel.

A list of the added features and resolved issues follows.

What's New in AVfusion Version 2020 R2.1

Active Directory Groups

Active Directory support has been greatly enhanced with the ability to map your already existing AD Groups into AVfusion Groups and permission schemes. Once this mapping has been defined, users will be given the right permission/group changes without any additional IT support.

Quick Record

AVfusion now supports the ability to launch a recording without any previous setup by pressing the button of an associated interview room with the Quick Record feature enabled. The recording will autofill the case name with "*RoomName QR*" and interview name with "*date time*". Case Name and Interview Name can now be edited.

Export to Evidence Locker (Archive)

Now available is the ability to set a user's permissions to classify an export as Archive. With this permission implemented, users can select the "Classify as Archive" check box on export. The Interview Search can also be filtered on Vaulted, Not Vaulted or All to aide in moving the recordings to the Evidentiary Locker.

Email Notification

The AVfusion Configuration utility has been updated with an Email Option that can be enabled or disabled. If enabled, it has configurable fields for an SMTP server as well as credential information, a list of email recipients, and email body. Upon completion of a recoding and/or export, this email, if enabled, would be sent to the intended recipients.

Connect to network on login

On a computer with multiple network interfaces, the AVfusion client network adapter selection was chosen by manual drop down in advanced settings. This process is now automated by the "Auto Update Listener Configuration" feature and is enabled by default in AVfusion Client's Advanced Settings. This setting prioritizes Ethernet over WiFi when both are present.

Thumbnail Improvements

The “On Created” field on the “Review Search Interview” thumbnails has a tool tip that displays last reserve and archive date.

Client Hidden Settings Password Protected

Password protection has been added to the Ctrl+Double Click hidden settings on the Client Login screen. If the Client cannot connect to a server, a default password will be accepted (admin/ AVF2admin) to open the hidden settings.

Expanded Functionality on Editing Interview Details

Interview’s Primary User and Case Name is now available to be edited post record.

Export History Improvements

Export of history logs did not have an indication of export initiation. History logs now include export initiation details (name of interview file and their Hash Code)

Resolved Issues

- Bookmark descriptions with more than 80 characters would not save and cause an error. The field now only accepts 80 characters maximum.
- AVfusion Server installation or upgrade would fail if Microsoft Visual C++ 2017, 2019 is already installed. The installer has been redesigned to leverage the pre-existing installation of Microsoft Visual C++.
- Export of interview history and notes would produce blank PDF form when document format PDF was chosen. Export feature has been revised to provide content when pdf is selected.
